Group Lease PCL Nominated for "SET Awards 2013" for "Best Company Performance Awards"

Group Lease PCL (GL), our group company which operates the motorcycle finance in Thailand, has been nominated for "SET Awards 2013" for "Best Company Performance Awards".

The Securities Exchange of Thailand (SET) has announced 458 listed companies, categorized according to the seven awards available, which are qualified to compete for "SET Awards 2013," on the 10th anniversary of this major event.

The announcement and event will be held on 20 November 2013 at the Aksra Theater King Power, Bangkok. GL has been nominated among other nominees such as ADVANC (AIS), INTUCH (Shin Corp) and Kbank (Kasikorn Bank) which are leading companies in Thailand. INTUCH (Shin Corp) was founded by the former Prime Minister Thaksin Shinawatra, owning companies such as mobile phone companies, airlines, TV stations, satellite managing companies. Kbank (Kasikorn Bank) is Thailand's 4th largest bank as well as one of GL's major banks.
